

Argent Comet Masters

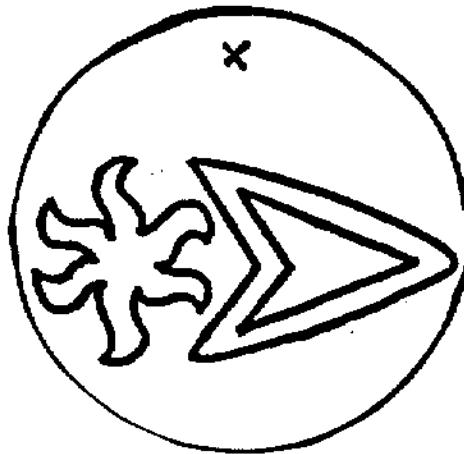
(FOR LEATHER TOOLING OR OTHER MEDIA)

Trace pattern onto wet leather with scribe

Instructions

1. Using swivel knife, cut around star and both inside and outside of comet's tail.
2. Plain bevel outside of star, and outside of comet's tail. Textured bevel inside area of comet's tail. The star and the tail should appear raised from the background.
3. Punch hole at "x" for cording or belt loop.
4. Paint or leather dye the background black.
5. Paint the star and the comet tail white or metallic silver.
6. Let dry. Finish with Tandy "Super Sheen" or wax finish.
7. Using a lark's head knot (or whatever works) attach a 24" cord to the top and tie loose ends together.
8. Volia! A finished Argent Comet.

This may be downsized for other mediums, such as embroidery acid etching or painting on wood. However, it should remain as a white or silver comet on a black background.
