

Meridian Cross masters

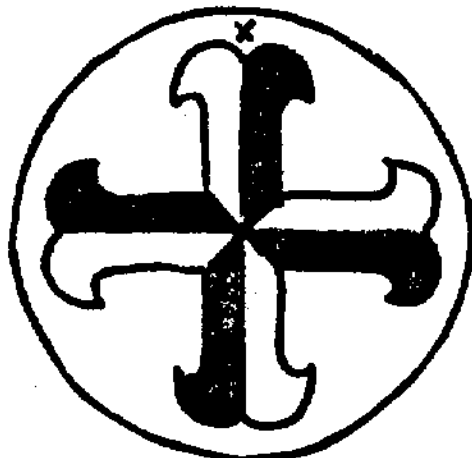
(FOR LEATHER TOOLING OR OTHER MEDIA)

Trace pattern onto wet leather with scribe
Be sure to include the inside details of cross.

Instructions

1. Using swivel knife, cut around outside of cross only.
2. Plain bevel around the outside, so the cross is elevated from background.
3. Punch hole at "x" for cording or belt loop.
4. Let dry.
5. Paint the black quarters with black acrylic paint. Paint the white quarters with white or silver acrylic. Leave background plain leather.
6. Let dry. Finish with Tandy "Super Sheen" or wax finish.
7. Using a lark's head knot (or whatever works) attach a 24" cord to the top and tie loose ends together.
8. Voila! A finished Meridian Cross.

This may be downsized for other mediums, such as embroidery acid etching or painting on wood. However, this is a fieldless badge and should have a plain background.
