change from: "...Kingdom Arts and Sciences Faire will be held on Memorial Day weekend of each year,..."

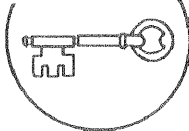
to: "Kingdom Arts and Sciences Faire will be held on the first weekend of June each year,..."
